Additionally, Dr. Ward is the Assistant Course Director for the Essentials of Patient Care Course, a 4-year longitudinal clinical skills course for the medical students at Emory. Dr. Ward is also a Small Group Advisor for the Osler Society at Emory School of Medicine. Dr. Ward's clinical and research interests are in systems of integrated care and the role of psychiatrists in addressing physical wellness.
